## Bubbles

**Helen's Hill Roma's Grace Blanc de Noir**  
+2022 +Yarra Valley, VIC

Made from 100% Pinot Noir hand harvested in Coldstream. Roma's Grace; named for Roma, founding partner and beloved Grandmother of the Helen's Hill family; this wine shares her grace. It's opulent and rich, with the ample texture and flavour characteristics of a Blanc de Noir.

**Rob Dolan Blanc de Blanc +V** 14 56  
+2021 +Yarra Valley, VIC

A stunning apéritif made by one of m+w's favourite local producers. Made from 100% Chardonnay grapes, this sparkling wine showcases citrus and stone fruit with a creamy mouth-feel.

**Amanti Prosecco DOC** 13 52  
+NV +Veneto, Italy

A true Italian Prosecco that is fresh and crisp with generous amounts of citrus and apple fruit. The perfect everyday bubbles for drinking anytime!

**Sir Paz Estate Sparkling Shiraz** 60  
+2019 +Yarra Valley, VIC

Only in Australia! This Sparkling Red showcases a stunning example of Australian creativity. Whiffs of plum and mulberry offer an approachable aroma, while dark berries and chocolate delight the tongue. The creamy texture allows the flavour to hang around before soft tannins come to cleanse the palate.

**75 Bollinger Special Cuvee** 110  
+NV +Champagne, France

From one of the few remaining family owned and run Champagne houses, Bollinger's NV is known for its dry and assertive style. This is the most accomplished expression of the Bollinger style, in the ability to recreate year after year, a blend that is constant in style and quality, in its bouquet, body, balance, vinosity and finesse. The high proportion of Pinot Noir helps create a full-bodied toasty character with pear, brioche and praline aromatics followed by apricot, semolina cake and tropical fruit flavours.

**Unico Zelo Seafoam PetNat** 46  
+2021 +Adelaide Hills, SA

Some red hot Vermentino from the Riverland was used to make the heart of this bubbly boi, alongside a small dose of Fiano. Sea Foam is salty yet refreshing. Imagine a bowl of nashi pears & green apples that are the core of the wine and add a touch of white nectarine, frangipani and a whiff of grassy freshness. Sea Foam is as close to the pure distillation of spring that has been produced.

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## A bit of Colour

**Innocent Bystander Moscato (275ml)**  
+2020 +Greater Victoria

Often referred to as “sunshine in a glass”, this iconic Australian wine is just the right balance of sweetness and acidity. Best enjoyed with a side of Summer.

**Unico Zelo Origami Rosé** 13 52  
+2022 +Adelaide Hills, SA

This is as Unico as a rosé can be; a blend of South Australia’s three key regions, Polish Hill Valley, Riverland and Adelaide Hills, it’s a house style; fresh, vibrant and bone dry.

**Rob Dolan Pinot Gris +V** 15 60  
+2021 +Yarra Valley, VIC

What was initially a mistake has now become a staple of the Rob Dolan portfolio. The skin contact during fermentation has produced a textural mouth-feel with a beautiful steelish pink hue. You’ll get flashes of pear and melon before a crisp fresh finish.

## White

**Boat O’Craig Black Spur** 13 52  
**Sauvignon Blanc**  
+2022 +Yarra Valley, VIC

Black Spur Sauvignon Blanc is made from grapes grown on the cool-climate vineyard at Healesville. Hand-picked, de-stemmed, some skin contact prior to pressing produces characteristic lime, passionfruit and minerality with a zesty, crisp finish.

**XI.XI (eleven eleven) Viognier by** 14 56  
**Georgia Dale**  
+2022 +Yarra Valley, VIC

Produced by a Halliday rated “Young Gun of Wine”, this wine provides a textured mouthfeel with hints of white peach and cantaloupe. The lingering acidity makes it a perfect match for anything with a touch of spice.

**Farina Pinot Grigio delle Venezie DOC** 12 48  
+2021 +Veneto, Italy

Grown on a soil of volcanic origin, one rich in lime and clay, combined with plenty of sunshine, this Pinot Grigio has a slightly aromatic bouquet of pear and pineapple, with a floral touch. The dry, soft structure and refreshing taste makes this ‘Italian’ widely appealing.

**Liz Heidenreich Riesling** 14 56  
+2022 +Clare Valley & Watervale, SA

The Riesling is quintessentially Watervale, lemon rind, fresh natural acidity and bath salts. Clean and fresh, bright and lively, with purity of fruit standing out. Natural acidity gives the wine persistence and length.

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## White

**Domaine Bouchard Pere et Fils 'La Vignee'**  
**White Burgundy**  
+2019 +Burgundy, France

A great representation of Burgundian Chardonnay by one of the regions largest producers. You will love the slight saline mineral characters that run through the frisky yet flavoursome white peach and pear fruit, infused with a drizzle of honeysuckle & light nutty oak cashew inputs. The oak sits in the background as it receives only 25% barrel ferment with the rest matured in stainless steel for approximately six months.

**Rob Dolan Black Label Chardonnay +V 13**  
+2022 +Yarra Valley, VIC

One of the prominent varietals of the Yarra Valley, this Chardonnay has all the highlights you would expect. It's golden colour brings flavours of stone fruit with a lingering finish. Time in French oak has added to its complexity and helps complete the package.

**Carmel Road Chardonnay**  
+2020 +Monterey, California, USA

Not the big, buttery Cali Chardy of old, this Monterey Chardonnay is so rich, it doesn't need oak. Refreshing acidity, courtesy of the cool climate, heightens the golden mango, tangerine and butter cream flavors, leading to a long finish complexed with a hint of yeast from sur lie aging.

**70 L.A.S. Vino Chenin Blanc Dynamic Blend 'CBDB'**  
+2022 +Margaret River, WA

Luck Art and Science are the founding principles of L.A.S. Vino wines. With flavours of pink grapefruit, coconut, passionfruit, passiona, pavlova and lime this wine screams natural. From a certified organic and bio-dynamic site at the northern end of the cape. The vineyard is mostly unkept, unpruned and lacks traditional trellising. The vines sprawl everywhere where pigs, geese, guineafowl and cows roam free. The site faces north with a little creek running through the middle of the vineyard. Native flowers and plants grow under the rows with no herbicides or pesticides sprayed and no cultivation. It is one of only a few certified bio-dynamic vineyards in the region and was one of the first to receive Demeter certification.

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## Red

**Rob Dolan Black Label Pinot Noir** +V 13 52  
+2022 +Yarra Valley, VIC

This big bodied Pinot is hand picked from a single vineyard in Seville. It's darker fruit characteristic is supported by an earthy undertone and finishes with some silky tannins.

**Holm Oak 'The Protégé' Pinot Noir** 58  
+2021 +Tamar Valley, TAS

This fresh, lively and aromatic Pinot shows lovely lifted strawberry and spice characters on the nose. These aromatics carry through to the palate which has fine, soft tannin, lovely bright fruit and juicy acidity. This is a gorgeously light Tasmanian Pinot Noir which is perfect drinking at any time.

**L.A.S. Vino Granite Grenache** 60  
+2022 +Margaret River, WA

This totally modern style of Aussie Grenache gets its name from the large granite rocks that punctuate the Ferguson Valley vineyard. The bush vines roam over the gravelly top soil 350m above sea level. It's medium-light red- purple colour in the glass, with woody, earthy, root vegetable aromas that point to whole bunch fermentation. Medium-bodied, the fruit is centre stage but it's not 'fruity'; it's more interesting than that.

**Unico Zelo Halcyon Days Nero D'Avola** 13 52  
+2020 +Riverland, SA

Sometimes there are those wines that are an utter joy to drink, that make you feel good - so good you'll catch yourself grooving! For us it's 'Halcyon Days'. Organically managed in Barmera by the Bassham family, the hot summers this grape adores gives the wine all the qualities we love in a great medium bodied red wine: fresh acidity, plush red fruits, a whisper of spice and the kind of structure that's ready for the esky. It's the red that puts a beaming smile on your face, a pretense free wine made for good times, good people and maybe a bite to eat. - UZ winemaker

**d'Soumah Barbera/Nebbiolo** 13 52  
+2021 +Yarra Valley, VIC

The classic pairing of two noble north-eastern Italian varieties combine here to create a savoury elegant red wine with soft fruit and charming length. The Nebbiolo brings excellent tannin and finesse with aromas of wild herbs and violets, while the Barbera compliments with ripe red berry fruit and velvet mouth-feel.

**Wine X Sam Primitivo** +V 14 56  
+2021 +King Valley, VIC

This Primitivo, also known as Zinfandel, is produced by Sam Plunkett with fruit from the Strathbogie Ranges. It has medium depth of cherry red showing a youthful magenta at the rim. Aromas of red berries and spice, with a violet and strawberry stem note. The wine has a fresh crunch on the palate. Tannins are supple with a velvety texture. The wine is well balanced and has good length of flavour.

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## Red

- Dominique Portet Fontaine Cabernet Sauvignon** 14 56  
+2020 +Yarra Valley, VIC
- The grapes are handpicked from a selected range of vineyards from the southern and northern ends of the Yarra Valley. This builds a true representation of Cabernet from the valley. The result is a wine with juicy, concentrated fruit with soft, silky tannins.
- Brown Brothers Limited Release Durif** 14 56  
+2018 +Heathcote, VIC
- The wine is a deep saturated black red colour with a vibrant purple hue. With aromas of spice, tobacco and dark berry fruits the scent of the wine leaps out of the glass. The use of predominantly older oak has given the palate an elegance and refinement that is not usually found in young Durif. Blackberry and plum fruit flavours are also a strong influence on the palate, offering an impressive intensity and a full-bodied finish.
- Rusden GSM** 12 48  
+2019 +Barossa Valley, SA
- Colloquially known as "Good sh\*t, mate", this one doesn't disappoint. With the traditional blend of Grenache, Shiraz and Mataro producing plenty of fruit and spice. The medium-bodied wine is full of raspberry and apricots with hints of dark berry fruit. The finish is gentle and long. Classic GSM.
- Levant by Levantine Hill Shiraz** 15 60  
+2020 +Yarra Valley, VIC
- An excellent example of a cool-climate Shiraz, produced by a renowned Yarra Valley winery. This wine provides intense aromas abundant of white pepper, cloves, cardamom pods, ginger, Damson plums with an underlying hum of stalky complexity. A fine acid line, chewy youthful tannins and high-tone oak define the palate supporting flavours of red and black fruits.
- Leeuwin Estate 'Art Series' Cabernet Sauvignon** 110  
+2018 +Margaret River, WA
- From the freakishly good 2018 vintage in Margaret River comes yet another phenomenal Cabernet Sauvignon. Intensity and density pairs with purity and elegance. Predominantly a blackcurrant thread on the palate, there is so much offering in layers. Bold, rich and contoured primary fruits engage with bright, almost mineral acidity, olive tapenade, iodine and sage. The tannins are silky, finely polishing the shape and finish on the palate.
- Sir Paz Estate Shiraz** 65  
+2017 +Yarra Valley, VIC
- One of the few producers in the valley to make a riper richer style. Plums and mulberry notes are the norm in this house. The 2017 also has elegant structure and lifted spice adding complexity. Persistent fine tannins hold flavour and give balance.
